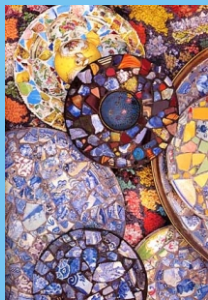

Italy Grants Asylum to Afghan Christian Convert

ROME, March 29 A man who faced the death penalty in Afghanistan for converting to Christianity was

secretly flown to Italy, where he was granted asylum under round-the-clock protection by the government, the Italian prime minister said Wednesday evening.

"He's already in Italy," Prime Minister Silvio Berlusconi told reporters. Mr. Berlusconi was vague about when the convert, Abdul Rahman, 41, had arrived here, saying he believed that it happened "overnight." The Italian news service ANSA reported that he landed in Rome on Tuesday night, accompanied by Italian secret service agents.

His arrival culminated several days of strong pressure on the American-supported government in Afghanistan, where Mr. Rahman had been jailed for weeks for his conversion. Many in Afghanistan called for his death, while Western nations demanded his release.

The differing reactions here and in Afghanistan to Mr. Rahman's release and his arrival in Italy seemed to underscore the continuing tension between the West and the Islamic world on issues like freedom of religion, freedom of expression and democracy.

"I say that we are very glad to be able to welcome someone who has been so courageous," Mr. Berlusconi told reporters here earlier in the day, before making Mr. Rahman's arrival public.

Later he said Mr. Rahman had "asked for asylum and it has been granted," after his cabinet took the unusual step of immediately approving it. But in deeply conservative and religious Afghanistan, politicians were outraged on Wednesday amid confusion about Mr. Rahman's whereabouts and fears that he might be taken from Afghanistan. Clerics called for him to be tried under Islamic law, which under conservative interpretations applies execution as a punishment for apostasy, and they led hundreds of people in demonstrations that also protested Western interference.

"We must call on the authorities in charge right now to stop him from going out," Muhammad Dawood

Zarif, an Afghan legislator and businessman, said in Kabul before Mr. Berlusconi's announcement.

Abdul Rab Rasool Sayaf, a conservative legislator, accused outside nations of plotting against Islam and Afghanistan.

"This is a net of conspiracies," he said. "I am sure there are people behind this who want to create problems between Afghanistan and the West from which they themselves would get their benefit."

Accordingly, Mr. Rahman's departure created the prospect of increased pressure on Mr. Karzai domestically even as it eased pressure from Western nations, including the United States, which holds out Mr. Karzai as the model of a moderate and modern Muslim leader.

Mr. Rahman, said to have converted to Christianity after working for an international Christian aid group, was jailed in Afghanistan after being accused of apostasy for abandoning Islam, although he was never formally charged. He was released to his family on Monday night, said the justice minister, Sarwar Danish.

The Bush administration pressed Mr. Karzai to resolve the case, but he resisted, citing separation of executive and judicial powers. Germany, Italy and Canada, which have troops serving in Afghanistan, and other countries voiced their concerns to Mr. Karzai's government.

On Saturday, Pope Benedict XVI, long outspoken about religious freedom for Christians in predominantly Muslim countries, sent a letter asking Mr. Karzai to pardon Mr. Rahman. The next day, the pope spoke at St. Peter's Square about his worries about "communities who live in countries where there is a lack of religious freedom, or where despite claims on paper they in truth are subjected to many restrictions."

The choice of Italy as a place of refuge for Mr. Rahman seemed to be a result of a combination of factors, including Italy's ties to the Vatican and to Afghanistan, along with close national elections here in which the Catholic vote is substantial.

Church ousts dominatrix from vicarage

JOHANNESBURG - A South African dominatrix has given up her battle to live in a vicarage, telling the church's congregation they can "shove" the disputed residence, a local newspaper reported on Wednesday. The Pretoria News said Marianne Ellis had been renting the manse, or vicarage, at the Doornkloof Nederduitse Gereformeerde Kerk near Pretoria for some time when church elders discovered her sideline as a local dominatrix and asked her to move.

Ellis and her husband at first sought to fight the church in court, but on Tuesday decided to back down, the newspaper said.

"It is a long story, but basically I am tired of fighting, really tired. They can take their manse back, in fact they can shove it," she told the newspaper.

Ellis, who said she was promised a long lease and option to buy the vicarage, had earlier showed reporters her "torture chamber" at the house but said she never had sex with her clients and was not running a brothel.

Following the dispute with the church, Ellis told the Pretoria News she was temporarily calling a halt to her career.

"But I will crack the whip again after we have moved. Then I will be back with a vengeance," the newspaper quoted her as saying.

Curtain Call: Churches finding a home in theaters

NEW ROCHELLE, N.Y. Pastor Reford Mott looks into two cameras as he stands at a makeshift pulpit on a temporary stage. Behind him, Mott's

image fills a large movie screen where an R-rated film will start in less than two hours.

Churchgoers in the top rows of the stadium-style seating in Theater 16 focus not on Mott, but on his real-time image as he preaches on the importance of community.

"Relationships are the glue that holds the church together," said Mott, pumping his fist. "Look at us. We're meeting in a movie theater, but we're still a church."

Mott's Family Christian Center is one of more than 250 churches meeting in at least 36 states. The mostly evangelical trend has caught on with nascent churches looking for space and parking, as well as established congregations wanting to reach a new audience.

"Church groups are now targeting the unchurched in a less threatening environment," said Mike Schonberger, vice president of sales at National CineMedia's CineMeetings and Events, a Denver company that has helped 95 churches find new homes in theaters across the country. "In many cases that environment is a theater, as opposed to a regular 'brick and mortar' building."

The group draws up contracts between individual congregations and theater chains like Regal Cinemas and United Artists. In the Houston area, Second Baptist Church occupies 19 theaters and is raising money to expand to cineplexes across the country.

The multimedia technology helps attract a young audience, said Leonard Sweet, a veteran professor at Drew Theological School in Madison, N.J., and the author of more than 30 books on religion and postmodern culture.

"In an attempt to use the language of the culture, we grew up and mastered book culture, and worship revolved around print," Sweet said of his generation. "Now ministers must learn the multimedia language of audio-video, software and the Internet."

National Community Church in Washington has done just that during eight years of meeting in theaters. The church recently branded itself "Theater Church."

Led by the Rev. Mark Batterson, the church has four services in two different movie theaters, averaging a total of about 900 on a typical Sunday.

"God has strategically placed us in a location where the unchurched are," Batterson said. "We've taken a place

where movies are shown that God might not consider kosher, and we use it for God's work."

Curious moviegoers often wander in to check out Theater Church. They need not check their popcorn at the door.

Most are singles in their 20s, Batterson said.

The pastor shows videos that he produced for a series titled "God at the Box Office." In one, "Mr. Incredible," Batterson wears the costume of the animated superhero of the same name and outruns cars, push-starts stalled vans and saves souls - all on the streets of the nation's capital.

For some, movie-theater church is only a temporary solution. Mott said he dreams of having a building of his own. While the space in Theater 16 has its advantages, Mott laments the time constraints placed by the theater's management.

"We have to herd them in and out like cattle," he said.

Volunteers known as "The Transformers" arrive at around 7 a.m. to begin setting up. The service lasts from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m., and Family Christian Center has to be out before the first movie of the day runs, usually around noon.

Fellowship after church is conducted in a small, roped-off area watched over by two security guards in black suits. It's a reminder that the church meets in rented space and must follow the owner's rules.

"In our 11-year history, we've never been able to put up a sign," Mott said. "I'd love to have our own sign, in bright lights and colors, (reading) 'Family Christian Church.'"

In the meantime, about 250 people worship on Sunday mornings, significantly more than the 12 or so that gathered in Mott's basement 10 years ago.

"I think we are redefining what it means to be a church," said church member Thandie Sigauke. "God is a creative God, and we are putting that creativity to use."

One of Family Christian's charter members, Nicole McIver, said she was initially reluctant to move into a movie theater.

"But the space just feels like church now," McIver said. "Seeing Pastor on the screen, and then the video announcements, that makes things more in-your-face, especially for people who are visual learners."

For Mott, the best benefit of meeting in a theater is encountering people who would never walk into a

traditional church.

"If Jesus were walking the Earth, he would go into the movie theater and engage people," Mott said.

According to Mott, Jesus would say, "I'm coming to where you are. Not in a cathedral, but to your cathedral. I'm bringing you the Gospel to where you hang out."

Dis godslastering, sê kerke oor foto's van gekruisigde Zuma

In kerkkringe is met skok gereageer nadat ondersteuners van mnr. Jacob Zuma hom gister voor die Johannesburgse hooggeregshof op 'n wit kruis uitgebeeld het.

"Waarom kruisig julle Zuma?" was op die kruis geveerf bokant 'n foto van die gewese adjunkpresident, wat tans op 'n klag van verkragting verskyn. Die kruis-idee is waarskynlik deur 'n berig in die Sowetan geïnspireer. Dié koerant het op 24 Maart oor 'n onderhoud met Zuma berig dat hy "deur die media gekruisig is". Zuma ontken egter dat hy hom met Christus vergelyk het, soos die berig se opskrif aangedui het.

Kerke het die Zuma-ondersteuners se optrede gister skerp veroordeel. "Alle grense van welvoeglikheid is oorskry. Ek dink dit is onaanvaarbaar dat 'n simboliese verband met Christus getref word - boonop wat betref iemand met dié soort klagte teen hom. Dit is godslastering in die ergste vorm," het dr. Isak Burger, president van die AGS, gesê.

"Ons is verskriklik ongemaklik oor dít wat buite die hof gebeur. Dit (die uitbeelding van Zuma aan die kruis) grens aan die Mohammed-spotprente. Die handves van menseregte is in gedrang," het dr. Kobus Gerber, hoofsekretaris van die NGK, oor die betogers se optrede gesê.

Chaos het gister buite die hof geheers toe vrouegroepe wat die klaagster in die verkragtingsaak steun, geïntimideer en byna oorval is deur sowat 100 Zuma-ondersteuners.

"Julle gee ons nie beskerming nie. Wie het daardie mense hier toegelaat? Daardie mense wou ons aanval!" het me. Miranda Friedmann, een van die klaagster se ondersteuners, vir die polisie gegil. Die groep Zuma-ondersteuners het van die afgesperde gebied in Kruisstraat weggebreek toe polisie die rooi kombi wat gereeld die Zuma-

betogers met musiek aanspoor, weggestuur het. Dié groep het 'n optog reg rondom die hof gehou, die verkeer ontwrig en weer by die afgesperde gebied voor die hof geëindig.

Daar is die groep van sowat 50 betogers wat die klaagster steun, uitgejou en moes die polisie ingryp om geweld te voorkom.

'n Beeld-fotograaf is in die chaos byna beroof. 'n Zuma- ondersteuner het die vermeende dief met 'n knopkierie bygedam.

"Die feit dat die regter gister (vroue)organisasies se aansoek om as vriende van die hof verklaar te word, van die hand gewys het, is 'n aanduiding van hoe beperk die begrip van vroueregte is.

"Ek is nie verras oor die optrede van die betogers nie.

"Hulle dink hulle het 'n reg om so op te tree, al is dit ongrondwetlik," het prof. Amanda Gouws, hoof van politieke studies aan die Universiteit van Stellenbosch, by navraag gesê.

Woede oor 'Karre maak seer, sê Prophet

Die gospel-groep Prophet het gister gesê hy verstaan die pyn waardeur Fokopolisiekar nou gaan met die kritiek wat dié groep kry, hoewel hy nie die 'Karre se stellings steun nie. Ds. Theo Geyser, een van die sangers in dié duo wat hoofsaaklik bekend geword het met sy liedjie Houtkruis, het gister in 'n ope brief gereageer oor Christene landwyd se "haatspraak" teen dié groep. "Ons het nooit van die term gospel gehou nie (hoewel beide van ons predikante is), bloot omdat ons nie regtig oortuig is dat Christelike etikette noodwendig iets Christelik maak nie," sê hy. "Maar ons ken van verbanning. Ons musiek was jare lank op radiostasies verban." Volgens Geyser was Prophet, wat bestaan uit hom en ds. Koos van der Merwe, in die verlede weens kritiek teen die kerk van godslastering beskuldig. Tog ondersteun hy Fokopolisiekar se musiek, al vereenselwig hy hom nie met die "f** God"-aanmerking van die baskitaarspeler Wynand Myburg nie. "Dit sal vir my en Koos moeilik wees om Wynand se uitspraak te ondersteun omdat ons Jesus liefhet. Dié uitspraak maak my seer.

"Wat net so seer maak, is Christene se reaksie op die hele sage. Dit verterk my vermoede dat koloniale Christenskap vandag steeds die hoofstroomteologie in ons land is.

"Christelike kruistogte soos dié bring groter verdeeldheid ."

Geyser reken sonde behoort nie gekategoriseer te word nie.

"Kan ek sonde kategoriseer?"

"Indien ek f** jou sê en Christus reken dat wat ek aan mense doen ek ook aan Hom doen, dan behoort ons konsekwent te wees. "
